MINAMI DEUTSCH, SIBIIR AND TOFT TO INFERNO 2025

We are adding three more bands to our line-up for Inferno Metal Festival 2025! All three bands will perform matinee concerts at Goldie during the festival. From Japan, we present the krautrock band Minami Deutsch; from Norway, we bring blackened hardcore with Sibiir, as well as heavy drone music from Toft.

MINAMI DEUTSCH

Minami Deutsch is a Krautrock band from Tokyo, formed in 2014 by Kyotaro Miula. Known for their hypnotic blend of Krautrock, psychedelia, and minimal techno, they gained global attention with their self-titled debut album in 2015, followed by the acclaimed EP Tunnel / New Pastoral Life in 2016. Their second album, With Dim Light (2018), was praised by Pitchfork and included performances at the prestigious Roadburn Festival, where they shared the stage with Damo Suzuki of CAN. In 2022, they released their third album, Fortune Goodies, showcasing an evolved sound influenced by their relocation to Berlin. Minami Deutsch has toured extensively across Europe, North America, Australia, and the UK, with standout performances at Desertfest Belgium, Roadburn Festival, and sold-out headlining shows. Now it is time to conquer Inferno Metal Festival!

SIBIIR

Oslo-based Sibiir, formed in 2014, delivers cold Norwegian metal blending hardcore, thrash, and black gaze. Their 2016 debut album gained critical acclaim and established their reputation for savage live shows at major festivals like Wacken, Roskilde, and Summer Breeze. Their 2019 sophomore album was nominated for a Spellemann ("Norwegian Grammy") in the Metal category. The band has just released their new album, Undergang, and is now ready to unleash its fury at Inferno Metal Festival for the first time!

TOFT

We're pleased to present Toft live on stage at Goldie. With contributions on more than 100 releases and a relentless worldwide touring effort it's safe to say we're dealing with a propper legend in the Norwegian Noise Scene. Apart from solo activities Toft is probably best known from Inferno friendly projects like Altaar and Utarm. Just to mention a few. Expect heavy drones and various degrees of degenerated musical styles of mischief.

The iconic Inferno Metal Festival started in 2001 – and is the longest-running metal festival in Norway – and one of the most important extreme metal festivals in the world. The Inferno Metal Festival takes place for four days on Rockefeller's two stages; Rockefeller and John Dee – as well as many smaller clubs around Oslo. The festival takes place during Easter when there isn't much else happening in Oslo. The festival is usually sold out and more than fifty percent of the audience is from abroad. Ticket sales go to the whole world, including China, Australia, Chile, Japan, Taiwan, Canada, the USA, Colombia, Argentina, and many more.
